

SOCIOLOGY CLASSES CANCELLED

Today, May 5, 1970, the faculty of the Department of Sociology passed the following resolution:

"In the face of the escalation of United States aggression against the people of Indo-China, we, the Sociology Department, in solidarity with the academic community in this country, have decided to cancel academic teaching for the remainder of the week in order to organize and mobilize efforts to end the war.

We, the Sociology Department, further demand that:

- 1) the United States withdraw immediately from Southeast Asia
- 2) all political prisoners in the United States be freed
- 3) ROTC be abolished on all campuses in the country
- 4) all weapons research and production and counterinsurgency research be ended at the University of California
- 5) established authorities move forthrightly to end America's racist foreign policy and racist institutions."

For the rest of the week, the Sociology Department Office will be used as a center for activities carrying out this resolution. There will be no business as usual.
