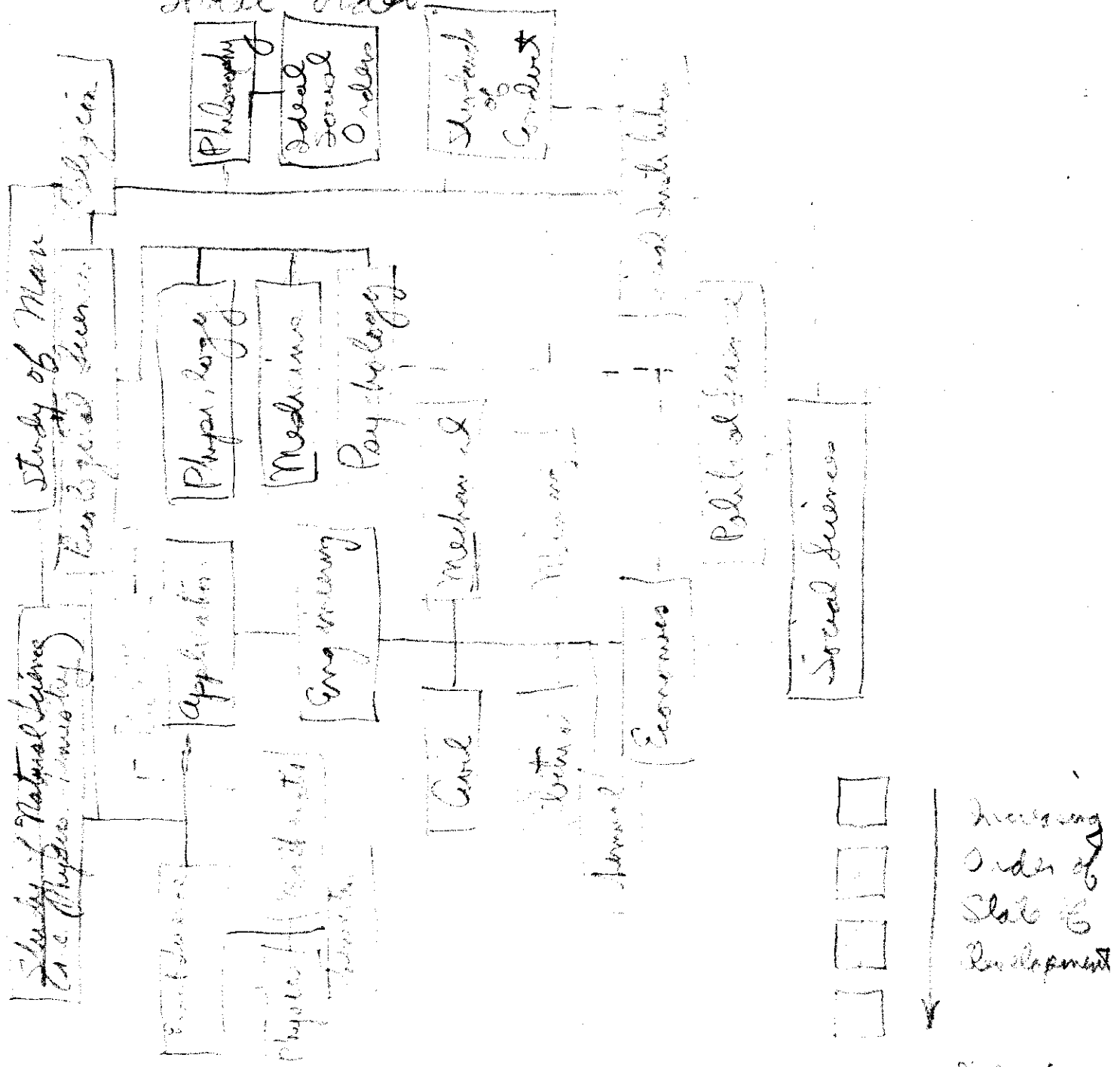


# Channing Club Program.
