1. Find out what the basic problems confront our society.
2. Find out who are competent authorities in sociological fields, such as economics, political science, philosophy, history, social institutions.
3. Discuss issues and refer technical questions to authorities in the field is question. An engineer should recognize that in a democracy, everything must be discussed, and that each person cannot be an authority in all fields, making it necessary to rely on testimony of experts in coming to decision. However the experts should organize their testimony so that the average person can see the general process of reasoning or the assumptions and interpretation of results of mathematical analysis.
