Abstract

The 1992 NATO Report "A Start of A Glacial" gives us more accurate data on the glacial cycles of Planet Earth for the last 3.12 million years. For the first time, we can see in the data the transition from a WARM EPOCH to the 6-th ICE EPOCH between 3.12 and 2.4 million years ago. The data also points to the possibility of a transition to the 24-th 70-120,000 Yr. GLACIAL CYCLE within 15 years. When the transition starts there are wild changes in the climate followed by a shortening of the food crop growing seasons, so that a combination of late planting and winter frosts coming before the crops are ripe will lead to massive food crop failures with a possible two billion people starving to death. Some members of the ruling elite have been discussing how the killing of two billion people by starvation or by a new virus like AIDS would solve the environmental problems of our planet without disturbing the plans of our capitalist leaders.

It appears to me that only socialist types of governments would have the power to put into practice environmental protections plans in time to prevent our planet from slipping into glaciation. I propose that sectors of the economy that pass environmental impact tests could be allowed to operate on a limited free market basis. For this inclusion of free market sectors meeting ecological tests within socialist governments, I would label this type of socialism as "ECOLOGICAL MARKET SOCIALISM."

To prevent the defects that arose in the 75-Yr. experiment with Russian Soviet Socialist organization, I propose two further modifications. (1) I propose that cybernetic systems analyses be maintained of all sectors of ECOLOGICAL MARKET SOCIALISM to maintain a visible understanding of how the system is working. For this I add another label: CYBERNETIC SYSTEMS'. (2) I propose that the distribution of resources in the system be accounted for by calculation of "entropy holes" corresponding to each major component. These "entropy holes" would be a modification of Shannon Information Theory from electrical engineering. For this I add another label: 'INFORMATION THEORETICAL.' Calculation of the "entropy holes" distributions

for finite distributions would give us measures of how well the system meets people's needs and the distributions over a continuous channel model would give us a measure of the balance between freedom and stability.

We now have the proposed system labelled as:

"CYBERNETIC SYSTEMS INFORMATION THEORETIC MARKET SOCIALISM."

The next problem is how are we going to convince people to make the change to C-SITE MARKET SOCIALISM ?

We shall insist on the use of the "dia logos" method of dialogue derived from North American Indians such as the Iriquois and the Mohawks. Fortunately we have this method of logic developed in the Fifth Discipline at MIT Sloan School of Management, so we can use a method with which the future business managers of the capitalist system are acquainted with. This technique is also described in the Workbook for the Celestine Prophecy, so the "evolutionaries" will have some knowledge of the logic method. These ideas will also be accesible to the "Evolutionaries" who are using the Book of Revelations from the Bible as their reference base.

By use of the "dia logos" techniques the capitalist system will be forced to face the ecological problems and the planets glacial cycle -- leading to the education of the general public on all these issues, so that whoever makes the decisions will be forced to openly use the "dia logos" system of logic to explain to the public what is happening.

It will be necessary to publish most documents on this procedure in both English and Spanish, in double column format, so that the ideas will be immediately accesible to most peoples of North and South America. It will necessary to make all documents available on electronic-computer bulletin boards with separate versions in English and Spanish ASCII.

Essentially, I, Fred Bernard Wood, will have to change my mode of operations from geophysical research to become a "Dialogue Facilitator." In addition to teams of people working together in a conference room, we will need to organize teams of people communicating world-wide through electronic-mail and computer bulletin boards.
